Buwame is a lunch stop; villages to provide fresh vegetables, fruits, kulau (fresh coconuts), entertainment (singing), and sightseeing. Overnight accommodation in Garewa, including dinner & breakfast

Day 3: Garewa to Jebo & visit to Orotaba village

Jebo: Demonstration of canoe making, sightseeing

Orotaba: Tattoo demonstration and traditional healing (ritual)

Accommodation including dinner & breakfast

Day 4: Jebo to Awanen Bay

Awanen Bay: Overnight stay - Lunch & dinner at Awanen

Sightseeing – paddle up end of the river & bird watching options

Day 5: Awanen Bay -Tufi

Lunch at Garewa

Overnight at Tufi Dive Resort including dinner & breakfast
