

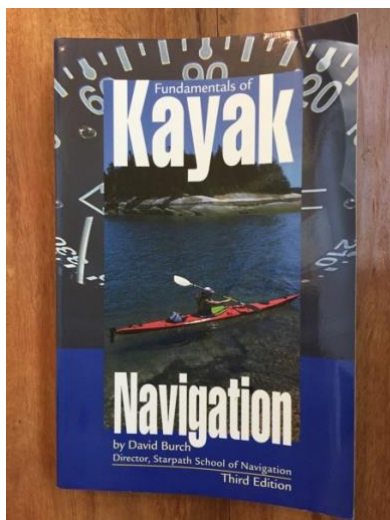

By David Burch 1999, good condition

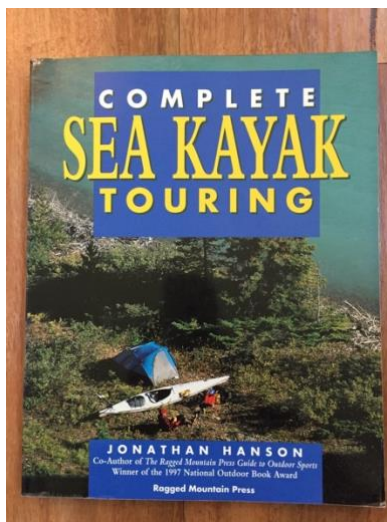
